COMPETITIONS – PRE PRIMARY

HAPPY FEET - PEPPY FEET

Participant: Pair - Mother/Father and Child

Grade: Playschool, Nursery, Junior KG & Senior KG

Duration: 2.30 Minutes Video

Fees: INR 200/-

Rules:

1. This is a competition for mother/father and child (daughter/son)
2. All participants are allowed to use props.
3. Music should not exceed 2.30 minutes
4. The participants will be marked on choreography, costume, rhythm and confidence.
5. 'Item songs' are not permitted.
6. **Last Date for receiving the performances is 19-Nov-20 (will be sharing the details shortly through which the performances will be submitted)**

RAZZMATAZZ

A fashion show with lot of fun, style and exuberance. Razzmatazz gives you the chance to showcase your talent, live the life of a showstopper and highlight the creativity of a designer. What sets the fashion show apart from other show is that you will have to answer some questions on the spot or showcase your hidden talents like dancing, singing, mimicry or mono-acting. Are you ready?

Number of Participants: 1

Grade: Playschool, Nursery, Junior KG & Senior KG

Duration: 3 Minutes Video

Fees: INR 200/-

Rules:

1. Participants will be sharing the videos in two parts. (**Will be sharing the details shortly through which the performances will be submitted**)
2. Part 1: Participants will walk the ramp displaying their costumes and also briefly introduce themselves.

3. Part 2: Display of Talent: dancing with Props, singing, mimicry, mono acting, speech or any other chosen by the participant.
4. Video should not exceed more than 3 minutes
5. **Last Date for receiving the performances is 19-Nov-20 (will be sharing the details shortly through which the performances will be submitted)**

LOOK-ALIKE

Children are great imitators. Let us give them an opportunity to imitate the person of their choice. This is a parent-child activity. All you have to do is dress identical and show the resemblance through costumes, both the parent and child must dress identically. What's more? You get a chance to look like someone famous. Number of Participants: 2 – 1 Adult and 1 child

Grade: Playschool, Nursery, Junior KG & Senior KG

Duration: 3 Minutes Video

Fees: INR 300/-

Rules:

1. As co-participants, only the mother, father, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother can participate with the child.
2. Judgement will be based on the degree of similarity between the adult and child. For e.g.: If the father has dressed up as Charlie Chaplin the child also needs to dress up in the same attire/costume.
3. You can dress up as a celebrity, community helper, etc. as per your choice.

CLAY PLAY

Number of Participants: 1

Grade Eligibility: Grade Junior KG & Senior KG

Fees: INR 100/-

Rules:

1. Material used for the sculptures must be eco-friendly.
2. Participants have to manage and arrange for their clay, play dough, or dough made out of flour, paint, paintbrush, etc.
3. Participants will be judged on the basis of their creativity, overall presentation and the best use of eco-friendly material.
4. Participants (students) must work under the direct supervision of their parent or legal guardian or another adult volunteer whom their parent or guardian has appointed in writing to be their chaperone.

4. Exceeding the time limit will lead to immediate disqualification.
